<b>Details</b>	<p>DOG ATTACK ON PERSON: Received call directly from Stephen he advises that he was biking down Songer Street just past the Turf at approx 11:00 and he saw the offending dog from last week's report and the man walking the dog again, Max was on a leash but not wearing a muzzle. As he passed the dog and walker the dog lunged up at bit Stephen's finger. Stephen stopped and got off his bike and stood behind it and Max was still at the end of his leash trying to get him. At this point the man walking the dog was pulling Max back and controlling him. Stephen and the man had a conversation about the muzzling as a result of the last report and Stephen said the man suggested he was given a muzzle for Max but didn't make him put it on. Stephen said to the man that he wouldn't report it but upon arriving home and speaking to his wife decided to call me. Stephen suggested another warning/infringement for failing to muzzle may be required and I advised the only way we can enforce muzzling is if we classify the dog as menacing. He is support of menacing class and will send through photo of his injury to his hand. Advised Max did draw blood. Advise Stephen I will be in touch.</p>
