Is anyone representing BVCG at the meeting tomorrow, particularly in regard to MTB Hub on Andrews Field.

I would like someone to pass my view to the council as I won't be there. It is as follows.

"My house is almost directly opposite the proposed MTB park and wash down area suggested.

I am definitely more in favour of option 3 (Hub entirely on the skid site) in order to keep noise, dust and activity away from the residential area.

We need to retain our green spaces for the growing population who partake in other recreational activities.

The RDA walk their clients horses across the field from their centre to reach the track at the far western end. Riders on bikes must already be a danger hazard for this activity. We have already been squeezed out of most of the valley by mountain biking activity this is getting more invasive. This is adjacent to a residential area, a place where people come home to, to rest and retreat.

If option 4 was used I would like to see it as a temporary venue until better access was provided to the skid site. I would also like to suggest a barrier of trees and a high fence between the parking and wash down area and the river to give some privacy, noise buffer and security to adjacent residents' properties.

There would also need to be barriers to keep vehicles off the grassed park and keep unwanted late night revellers from parking. In the past we have had a problem with vehicles and people damaging the park in the night when there was no locked gate.
