The Youth Development in Partnership workshop took place on the 10th April 2018. It brought together young people, local and central government agencies, NGOs and funders to discuss ways to measure success as we plan to deliver Council's Youth Strategy. The workshop was in two parts, the morning focussed on developing a shared understanding of what youth development in partnership looks like in our local context. The afternoon brought in 9 Government departments, two NGOs and one multi-agency partnership with an interest in young people to explain what data they collect and why. The final part of the afternoon started the discussion about developing shared indicators to focus our work and measure success. The day was facilitated by Anya Satyanand, the CEO of Ara Taiohi, the peak body for youth development in New Zealand and the information we gathered was invaluable in terms of focussing our work for Nelson's young people.
