# 0. Late Item: Community Housing: Update on Divestment

Document R18060

A public excluded report titled Community Housing: Update on Divestment is to be considered as a major late item at this meeting.

Section 46A(1)-(6) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 and Standing Order 9.8 require that agendas are distributed with the associated reports.
