The areas of our concern and the action we wish council to take are as follows:

Part 3

 NFL-O2 Maitahi/Mahitahi/Maitai River Valley [RP, DP] The special characteristics and values that define the Maitahi/Mahitahi/Maitai River Valley are maintained.
 Add: "in perpetuity."

Also add: "There shall be no further residential development in the Matai river catchment." as per Nelson Urban Growth Strategy 2006 (supported by 91% of respondents)

NFL-P5 Remedy or mitigate adverse effects on Maitahi/Mahitahi/Maitai River
 Valley values and attributes [RP, DP] In the Maitahi/Mahitahi/Maitai River Valley,
 actual and potential adverse effects on the values and attributes described in APP38
 Delete: Special landscape values associated with Maitahi/Mahitahi/Maitai River Valley will
 be remedied or mitigated.

Replace with: "No development will be permitted which will have any adverse effect on the special landscape values associated with Maitahi/Mahitahi/Maitai River Valley."

Delete:The Maitahi development area chapter of the Draft Nelson Plan, including the extent of the development area boundary, will be developed and published once an anticipated Private Plan Change application process for this development is resolved. In the interim, the urban expansion area identified in the Future Development Strategy as Kaka Valley, in the Maitai Valley area, is shown as the Maitahi Development Area on the Nelson Plan maps.

Add: "The Kaka Valley is an area located adjacent to Branford Park and the Centre of New Zealand recreational area. As such it could be considered for incorporation into the adjacent park and recreational areas and zoned for future use as a regional park."

The 9,636 signatories to this petition request that the Nelson City Council does not accept or approve any private or public action that will lead to or result in the rezoning of rural land in the Kaka Valley as residential land.
